When your child should self-isolate

Your child should self-isolate if:

- They have any symptoms of coronavirus (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- They have tested positive for coronavirus – this means you have coronavirus
- Someone they live with has symptoms or tested positive
- Someone in your support bubble has symptoms and your child has been in close contact with them since their symptoms started or during the 48 hours before they started
- Someone in your support bubble tested positive and your child has been in close contact with them since they had the test or in the 48 hours before their test
- Your child has arrived in the UK from a country with a high coronavirus risk – see GOV.UK: how to self-isolate when you travel to the UK

They should self-isolate for at least 10 days. You may need to self-isolate for more than 10 days if you get symptoms while self-isolating or your symptoms do not go away.
