Once again, many thanks for your wonderful support during one of the most challenging periods we have experienced in our life time.

I am writing to inform you of some of the changes that are required, to ensure we keep everyone safe in September.

The Government guidelines state, that where possible, we need to have staggered start and end times to the school day. In addition, where possible to also have different routes into school to avoid congested areas and enable everyone to safely social distance.

Please see the table below which informs you of the start, end times and your child's designated entrance and exit into school.

If your child's class has been directed to enter school via the school field gate, they will need to be escorted safely around using the zebra crossing, past the Children's Centre and up to the field gate. A member of staff will receive the children at the field gate and safely direct them onto the playground.

Where children that have been directed to enter school via the main entrance, we would appreciate if any accompanying adults avoid waiting and leave the school site promptly.

All the classes directed to use the normal school route, will leave their child at the gate and exit through the carpark. All school staff will be instructed not to use the main carpark during specified times.

When you are dropping off and collecting your child at each end of the school day, we request you arrive and leave promptly, to enable us all to keep safe and avoid another lockdown.

These times may be revised in September should any issues arise.
