A number of children and adults have been witnessed not using the pedestrian crossing. Can we please remind everyone about road safety and ask all adults to set a good example to our children.


#### **ATTENDANCE**

Lateness = Lost Learning (figures below are calculated over a school year)	
5 minutes late each day	3 day lost
10 minutes late each day	6.5 days lost
15 minutes late each day	10 days lost
20 minutes late each day	13 days lost
30 minutes late each day	19 days lost

Ceri Morgan from Young Carers visited school this week to deliver an assembly with Year 1 and Year 2 children, and workshops with Year 3 - 6.

A young carer is a child aged between 6 – 18 years who has a caring responsibility for a loved one they live with. Their caring responsibility will often be supporting a parent or sibling who has an impairment such as a physical disability, mental health issues, substance misuse problems and / or other limiting conditions including terminal illness. Young carers are often isolated and encounter more barriers when trying to achieve positive things throughout their childhood.
