

COVID 19 UPDATE - LATEST CHESHIRE EAST GUIDANCE -FRIDAY 8TH OCTOBER

Pupils who are household contacts of a positive COVID case are advised to stay at home for 5 days, limit social contact and get a PCR test before coming back to school. It is also advised that pupils take daily Lateral Flow Tests on their return to school for the remainder of the 10 day period.

EMERALD APP - ALERT

Serious concerns have been raised with the popular chat app called <u>Emerald</u>. The app claims that you can 'meet friends from around the world at the click of a button'. A simple registration process asks users to confirm they are 18 or above and then enables them to access thousands of people from around the world.

As the purpose of the site is to connect users with random strangers around the world, young people would be at risk of unwanted or inappropriate contact. There is also the potential for users to see inappropriate and illegal content.

This site is not suitable for anyone under the age of 18 and we would advise parents to apply appropriate age restrictions to broadband and devices to prevent access.
