**KS2 – Mr Williams' class achieved 99.3%. Very good!**



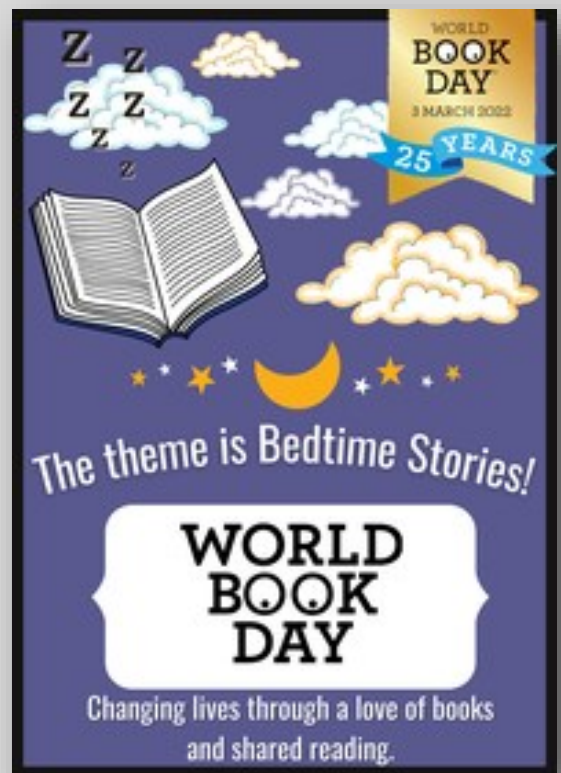
## WORLD BOOK DAY

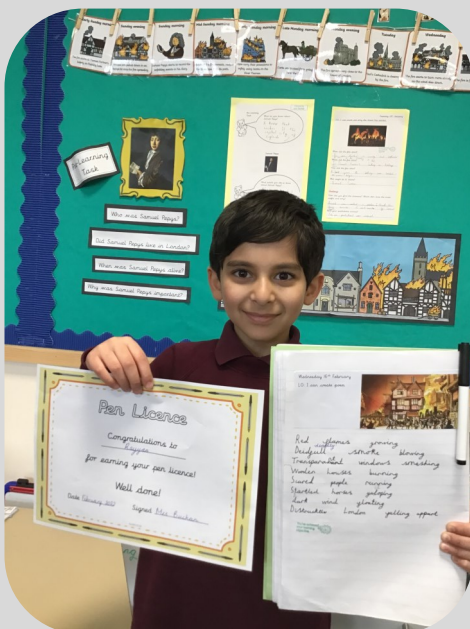
