GREAT FIRE OF LONDON

As part of Year 2's history topic, they have been learning all about The Great Fire of London. For their half term project, the children designed and created their own models of a Tudor house. Today, the children developed their understanding of how quickly the fire spread in 1666 by using their buildings to recreate Pudding Lane, before a member of the Site Maintenance Team set fire to the "baker's".
