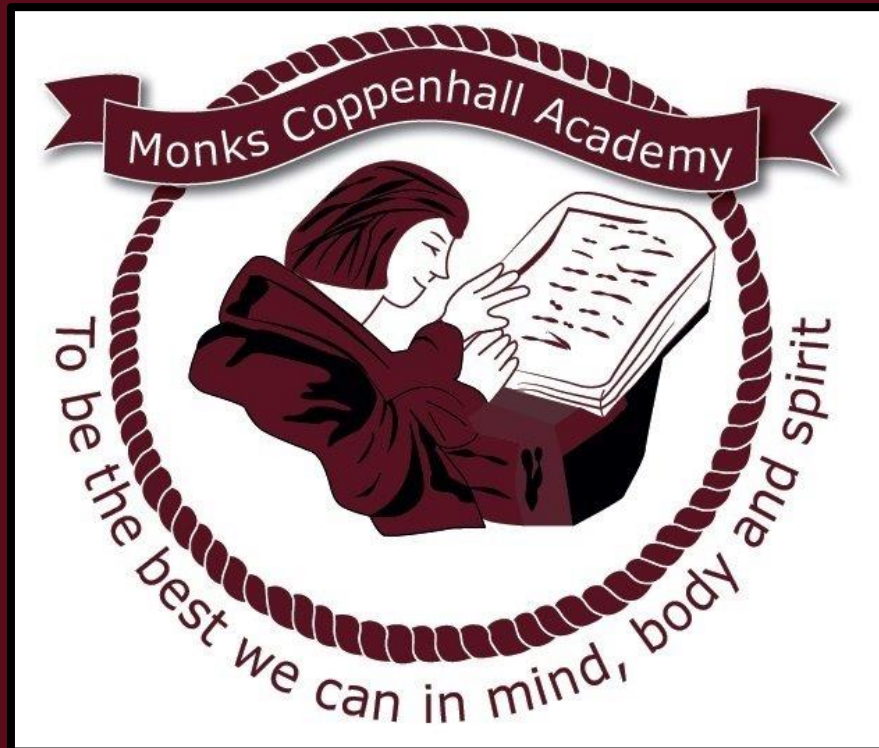

SATS

Homework

Leading up to the SATS, homework will be given to the children on a Friday and will then be marked the following Friday.

Homework will include:

- English Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation
- Maths (Arithmetic and/or Reasoning)
- TT Rockstars (20minutes +)

Times Table Rockstars

For the last few years, the children have been given individual usernames and passwords to access the games available on Times Table Rockstars. This can be accessed through either the internet or by downloading the free app. The games encourage children to develop their times table knowledge, as well as the related division facts, in a fun way. It is vital that the children know their times tables and can recall them quickly in order to support their mathematical learning.

Class Timetable Variations
