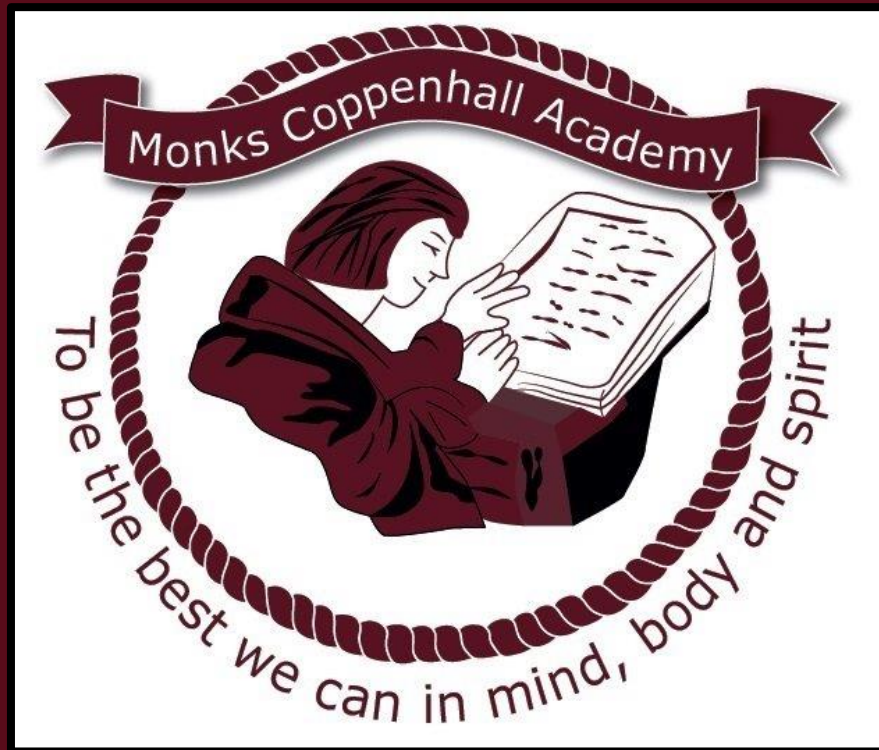

# On the days of the SATS

# SATS

# Homework

Leading up to the SATS, homework has been given to the children through out the week.

Homework will include:

- English Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation
- Maths ( Arithmetic and/or Reasoning)
- TT Rockstars (20 minutes +)
- Reading (20 minutes +)
- Spelling Frame ( free app)

# Class Timetable Variations

Up until the SATS finish, the children's timetable may vary to meet their learning needs. The children may take part in additional Maths and English sessions, not only to improve knowledge, but also to improve test strategies and timing.

The children will still be having regular foundation subjects.



# How Can Parents Help?

- Ensure the children are having plenty of rest and are going to bed on time.
- Help the children to complete homework on time
- Access some past papers, so the children can practice at home (answers also available)
- Help the children to practice the spelling of the Year 3 & 4 and 5 & 6 Spelling list that they are unsure of. Spelling frame can be used to help and is free online.
- Continue to ensure the children are reading each night
